- leggings " " " "
- baseball shirts " " " "
- sweatshirts " " " "
- smartphone cases, iPad cases, laptop cases
- pillows.....(not that someone might want these, I am just telling you what they offer)

- coffee mugs for home and coffee travel mugs for your car
- photographs printed in numerous sizes (framed or un-framed)
- postcards, greeting cards, and posters

You will place your orders online via the website RedBubble.

You will pay RedBubble via credit card.

RedBubble will ship your items directly to you.

RedBubble will guarantee and return any items per their policies.

--Hopefully by May / June or so, I will send everyone a link that will take you to the HIKANATION PAGE within the RedBubble website. The designs will be posted there and you can knock yourself silly and order whatever items you wish. Currently the HIKANATION PAGE is not "public" but it will be in the near future. Give me a month or so, to upload all the designs.

--As a reference, I have had some personal shirts made and the quality is quite nice. They use a good quality fabric and nice vibrantly printed colors. I have not seen any of their sweatshirts, hoodies, cups, etc, but I will try a few "test orders" myself to insure that the quality is acceptable. I anticipate no problems in quality.

--Now, Doug has something entirely different going on I think his idea is to arrive at a quantity of mugs that he will personally order. I do not know if he plans to front the money himself, and get re-imbursed in Colorado by each individual. Ask Doug. I have encouraged Doug to continue to pursue his idea, because there may be hikers who are not fluent in computers and ordering items online. Doug's method will be ideal for them. **Ask Doug about details** . . . I know very little about his project.

Meanwhile, feel free to explore redbubble.com to get an idea of what items they offer and how they look. At this time, the HIKANATION PAGE is not accessible, but you can still look at generic items.
