



STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY GUARD SERVICE

This Eighth day of April 19 80, the CAL STATE PATROL SERVICE, INC. a duly registered Private Patrol Operator, operating under a license issued by the State of California, hereinafter referred to as CAL STATE, and the American Hiking Society have mutually arrived at the following understanding:

W I T N E S S E T H

The CAL STATE, in consideration of payments agreed on herein, will provide services as follows:

I

The guard on duty will be alert for the following situations:

1. Possible break-in or illegal entries.
2. Thefts, burglaries, and vandalism of property.
3. Vagrants and loiterers on or about the property.
4. Any possible fire hazards.
5. Unauthorized persons in restricted areas.
6. Careless or suspicious activities in areas where articles that can be pilfered are stored or handled.
7. Equipment carelessly misplaced or improperly stored.

9. CAL STATE is to keep money collected until Monday morning (April 14, 1980) when the bank deposit is to be made.

The guard will also respond to any call coming under the heading of security.

II

CAL STATE's hours of service will be as follows:

Saturday, April 12, 1980	8:30am to 11:30am
Sunday, April 13, 1980	4:30am to 8:00am

III

As a result of consideration of the performance of the aforementioned provisions and covenants by CAL STATE, the American Hiking Society agrees to pay CAL STATE the sum of \$325.00 (five guards @ \$10.00 per man hour

an invoice after completion of services for 32.5 total hours of service) and payment is to be made within fifteen (15) days after it is received. A late payment charge of 1% of the unpaid balance will be applied to any account that is outstanding for more than 30 days.




This agreement is to extend for a period of two days beginning April 12, 1980 and terminating April 13, 1980

In the event that both parties wish to terminate the agreement prior to the ending date or if one of another of the parties involved does not live up to the covenant herein contained, a seven (7) day written notice of termination must be submitted.

The undersigned understands that this contract contains the entire agreement and they further understand that no other agreement written or verbal is binding.
