There will be a memorial service for Philip Arthur Atkins, 51, of Chico, Sunday, Feb. 19, 2006, 2 p.m. at the Congregational Church of Chico, 1190 E. First Avenue. A contender with cancer, he died peacefully Feb. 10, 2006 at the home of his parents, with family members present.

Philip was born Aug. 2, 1954 in Berkeley, Calif. to Leland and Martha Atkins. The family moved from Orinda to Chico in 1961 where Philip attended Rosedale School, Chico Junior and Senior High Schools, and Chico State University. He was especially grateful to members of the Centerpointe Church of Fairfax, Va., for their friendship, spiritual support, and assistance with his move to California.

Besides his parents, he is survived by brother Paul Atkins of Chico, sisters Linda Campbell of Newcastle, Calif., and Karen Jimerson of Cameron Park, Calif., plus four nieces and one nephew.
